### H. S. Band Awarded Superior Rating

The Highland Park High School band was awarded a second division or superior rating in the National band contest, Region 3 at Elkhart, Indiana, last Saturday. Twenty-seven class A bands in all from the states of Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Michigan qualified for the finale at Elkhart. Of these seven were all national champions in years past also. Other bands from this locality placing in the second division were Proviso, Waukegan, Elkhart, Quincy, and Farragut (Chicago). East Aurora and the John Adams High School of Cleveland, both former National champions, also placed in this division.

The judges were A. A. Harding, director of bands at the University of Illinois; Victor Grabel, noted composer, arranger and professional bandmaster and Carl King, noted march composer.

The sight reading contest was judged by Raymond Dvorak, director of bands at University of Wisconsin; Neil Kjos, music publisher; Clifford Lillyn, director of bands, Englewood High School, Chicago.

The soloists competed on Thursday and Friday, Jerry Daum placed in the first division in the French horn contest; Art Pier, second division in the clarinet contest; Julius Laegler, third division in the

alto clarinet contest; Leslie Rankin, second division in tenor saxophone contest, and the girls' woodwind trio, composed of Audrey Prindle, Jeanette Bryant and Enid Ball, second division in the ensemble contest. The bands placing in the first di-

vision (highly superior) were Morton, Elkhart, Joliet, Lane and Harrison (of Chicago), Urbana, and Cleveland Heights.
