Help him by being just a little more considerate. Give him time to

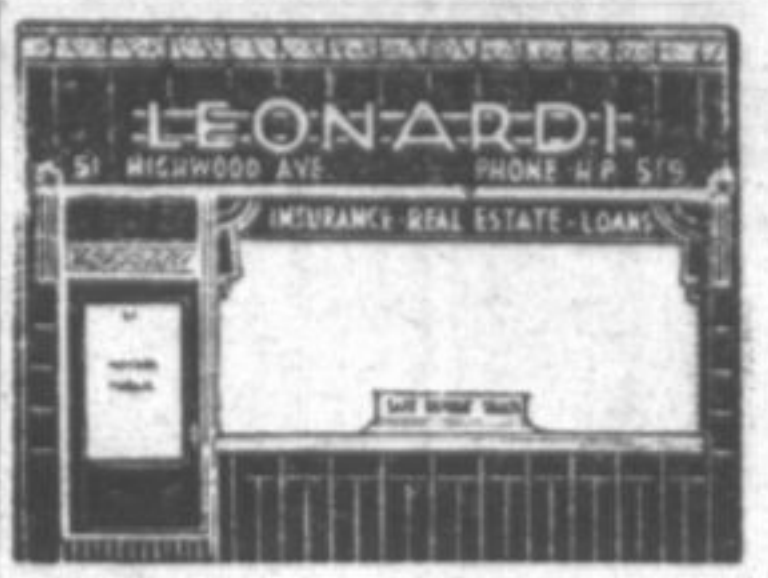
deliver your goods so he will not be rushing through the streets with the possibility of injuring people. It's smart to be careful.
