Nelson, County Treasurer and ex-officio County Collector of Lake County, in the State of Illinois, will apply to the County Court of said County on the 16th day of September, for judgment against the owners of the lands and lots mentioned, and described in the following list of delinquent lands and lots for the general taxes and personal property tax attached thereto for the year 1937, together with interest and costs due severally thereon and for an order to sell said lands and lots for the satisfaction thereof. Public notice also hereby given that on the second Monday of October, to wit: On the 16th day of October, A. D. 1938 all the lands and lots, for the sale of which an order shall be made, will be exposed to public sale in the County Court Room, in the building where said County Court is held in the Court House at Waukegan, in the said County, for the amount of taxes, interest and costs due severally thereon, except such as shall have been paid at said time of sale. Said sale shall commence at 9 o'clock A. M., Central Standard Time, on the 16th day of October, and to continue from day to day, until the same shall be completed and if for any cause such judgment shall not be rendered on the said 16th day of September, then such sale will be made on the second Monday after such judgment shall be rendered commencing at 9 o'clock in the forenoon of such second Monday.

Costs on each tract or description of land 25 cents; on each lot or description of lot 16 cents. Also interest at the rate of 1 per cent per month will be added after June 1st on the first installment and September 1st on the second installment.
