

Needed Revision Of Social Security To Be Discussed

"Needed Revision in Social Security Legislation" will be the subject of the address which Mr. Frank Bane former director of the Social Security board and recently appointed director of the Council of State Governments will make for the December meeting of the League of Women Voters which will take place December 21 at the Y.W.C.A. at 1:15.

Mrs. Philip Ringer program chairman in announcing the program feels that the league is to be congratulated in securing Mr. Bane whom is a foremost authority on the Social Security Act and eminently fitted to discuss the weaknesses and strengths of this recent development in American social legislation. Mr. Bane's experience in the public welfare field began in 1920 when he became secretary of the Virginia State Board of Charities and Correction. In 1923 he became director of public welfare in Knoxville, Tenn. and later returned to Virginia first as a professor at the University of Virginia and later as commissioner of public welfare of Virginia. More recently he was director of the American Public Welfare association, resigning his post three years ago to become director of the Social Security Board.

An enthusiastic and hard-working group of members of the Highland Park league under the leadership of Mrs. Ferdinand Kramer has been meeting faithfully at the Public library the last three Tuesdays making a cooperative study of South America with a view to understanding the problems of the Lima conference now in progress. Canada in the Pan-American system; progress in elimination of trade barriers, progress in promoting cultural relations and action on political and civil rights of women.
