The Council Discusses Eligibility Law

In a meeting of the entire student council on December 7 a possible revision of the eligibility law was discussed.

Because some students feel that the eligibility laws are too strict, Keith Shay suggested that the following revisions be made: instead of requiring that a student in office have no grade less than a "C", change the law so that he may have an average of "C" for the six weeks with no failures and no grade lower than a "C" for the semester.

Laurence Wygal moved that the requirement be an average of "C" for both the six weeks period and the semester. All changes suggested were voted down for the reason that most of the councilors felt that a person who can't make a better grade than a "D" is not capable of holding an office requiring ability and responsibility.

New Plan Adopted To Improve English

A new method to help improve the English used in all of the classes is to be tried in the Highland Park high school.

Every teacher will be given some cards to be filled out if a pupil in his class shows a marked deficiency in English grammar, punctuation, or spelling. This is to help the students learn that correct English should be used in all classes and not just in the English classes.

The cards will be sent to the English teacher of the student who shows a language deficiency, and the English teacher will try to help the pupil overcome his particular difficulty.

A card will not be filled out just because a student misspells or mispronounces one word, but if he shows a definite weakness in English usage, his English teacher will receive a card.

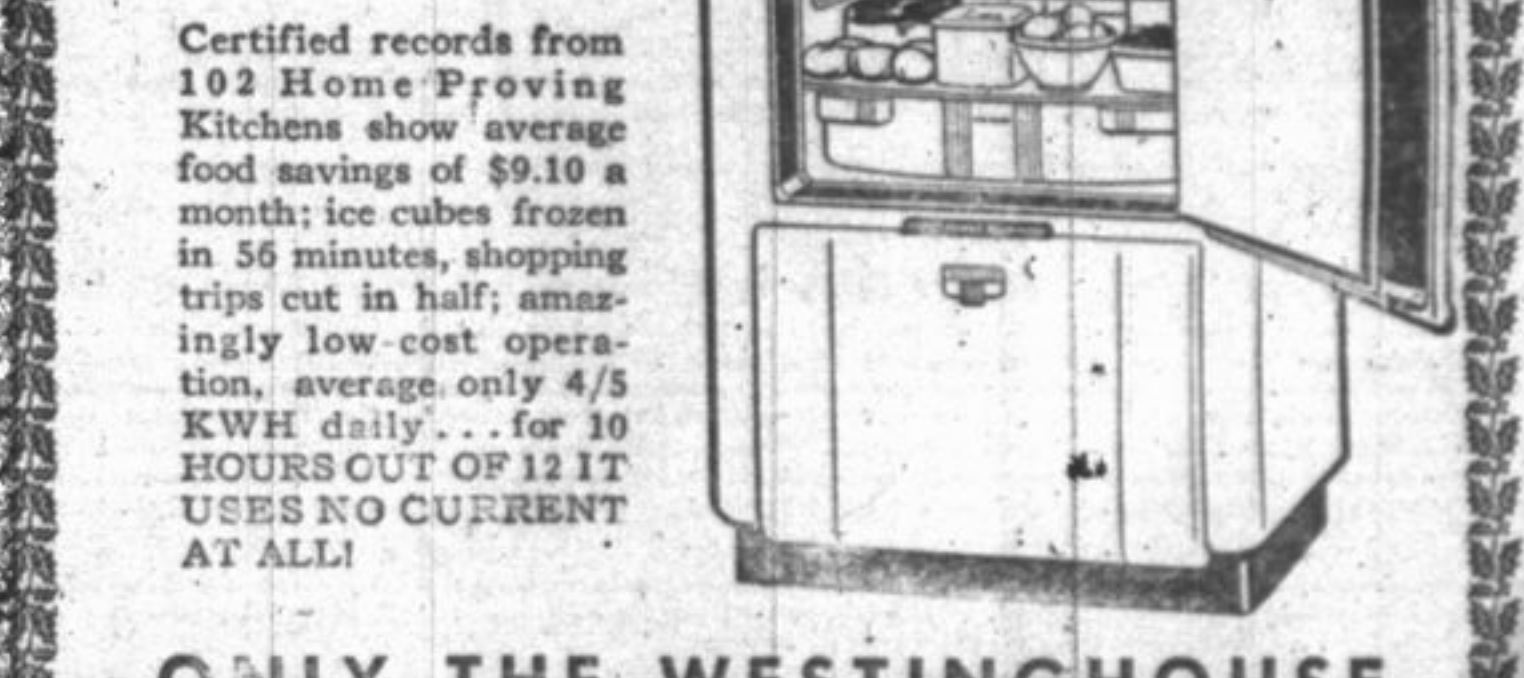
