Oldest Member Of Local D.A.R. Chapter Passes On Sunday

Mrs. Rosaline Potter Brown, for 14 years a resident of Highland Park, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alfred S. Burdick, 344 Oakland Avenue, at 3:00 o'clock Sunday morning. Mrs. Brown was born April 15, 1844, at Berlin, New York. Had she lived into the middle of April this year, she would have reached her 95th birthday. She had lived in Illinois from 1857, when as a child of thirteen years of age, she came out with her family to Peoria county where they settled. In 1865 she was married to Harvey S.
