Proponents of a greater degree of home rule for municipalities and those who feel that individual citizens should have more of a voice in determining what streets are made into permanent truck lines believe that objections should be filed before the granting of a route and a certificate. These persons hold that it would be easier to prevent picking an improper route than it would be to oust a company after it had been using the route for some time. Their position is given added weight in view of the fact that the powers of the department to assign routes apply to truck movements originating outside the corporate limits of municipalities and passing through or around them. The department will not route truck movements confined entirely within the limits of a com-
