Another Hit at the Lake Zurich Playhouse This Week

The Lake Zurich Playhouse continues to add smash hits to its 1939 record and on July 28, 29 and 30 will present the well-known mystery drama, "Love from a Stranger."

Sidney Breese and Mary Elizabeth Aurelius—both directors of the Playhouse and both members of the Goodman Theatre staff, will play the leading roles. Mr. Breese and Miss Aurelius were important factors in the success of "Our Town" and their presence in this week's cast promises a high ranking performance.

"Love from a Stranger" is one of those psychological mysteries which gets away from the showprow devices of the old time thrillers. It is replete with straight dramatic interest which finds just the right comedy relief in the acting of Gloria Hopkins and Don Hamner.

Radio listeners will be interested to know that Mr. Breese was cast as Doctor Thompson in the popular serial "Road of Life."

Mr. Henry Kurth who came to the Playhouse with a reputation for unusual talent as designer has added materially to his array of interesting sets so far this summer. This week's set is being built under Mr. Kurth's supervision.

The Playhouse is proving a delightful place for unusual summer entertaining. Hostesses bring whole parties from the north shore, from Barrington, Elgin and other surrounding communities and it has become advisable to phone in advance for reservations. Much Interest Shown in Playground Doings

Five weeks of playground activities have been completed on the playgrounds operated by the Park Board of Highland Park. Children who have been out of town or have been engaged in other things so far this summer are still registering and it is hoped that every child in Highland Park will have taken advantage of the recreation offered on the playgrounds before the season is closed on August 18th. Figures to date show that there have been over 20,000 in attendance, both adult and children, on the playgrounds during the first five weeks of operation. The program for the children on the playgrounds is built around two major activities, swimming and baseball. Lessons are given in swimming every Wednesday and Friday morning with many attending and learning to swim. Baseball games are played on other mornings of the week, each playground

following a schedule of games that gives everyone a chance to participate.

To vary the program other activities like horseshoes, badminton, tennis, and volleyball are offered in the afternoons. Emphasis is placed not only on skill in the games but in sportsmanship as well so that as the children grow they may plan their own leisure time program and get the most enjoyment from it.

The adult program, carried on at Lincoln and Sunset is one in which much choice is left to the individual. Whether it is to be volleyball, badminton, tennis, horseshoes, baseball, or just to watch the others in their games depends upon the adult. All these activities are offered to anyone who cares to take part. The most popular form of recreation among the older people still seems to be ball games. Individuals and families in the community who have not as yet taken advantage of the recreation program offered by the Park Board are invited to attend,

participate, or inspect any of the program. It is the intent of the Park Board to co-operate with any group or individual as much as possible in order that everyone has an opportunity to participate in a well rounded program of recreation. The schedule for the week of July 31 is as follows:
