

# Girl Scouts NEWS AND NOTES

Several Highland Park Girl Scouts have returned from Camp O'The Hills, Jackson, Michigan with many exciting tales of camp life. Grace Williams said that to her the camp fires were most impressive. ## New Airport Under Construction on Milwaukee Avenue

A new commercial airport to serve Chicago and its suburbs is under construction on Milwaukee avenue, 1/4 of a mile north of Golf road. Three hangars and an adequate number of runways are being built on the 190 acres, which adjoin the property of the Northwest Gun club, A. H. Kunath, president of the new airport enterprise, expects to be under way and ready for business within two weeks.

According to his plans, Mr. Kunath will go into business with 12 planes of all types. These will include special training ships for instruction, and cabin models for daily passenger flights.

Four pilots will be on duty at the port for training, as well as flying the passenger planes. A club house is also planned to adjoin one of the hangars.

Passengers will be taken aloft in a Ryan FG, it was explained.

## Runs Out of Gas; Auto Hits Car

A car owned by Edward Therrien, Sr., 62, of 745 Ridgewood drive, was badly damaged shortly after 5 o'clock last Wednesday evening when it was struck by another car on Skokie highway, just north of Park avenue.

Therrien had run out of gas as he was driving south on Skokie road, and was being pushed by his son Edward into the fuel yard on Park avenue. A car also headed south on Skokie driven by Edward Jocus, 28, of Waukegan, crashed into Therrien's car as he attempted to avoid the accident. Harman Rye, owner of the car, who was riding with Jocus, was injured and Jocus suffered injury to his right knee and ribs. Both were cared for by Dr. H. B. Roberts at Highland Park hospital.
