Leading roles in the picture will be played by Helen Doland, Peter Trucano, George Rich, Adam Bernardi, Ambrose Cantagallo, Louise Leonardi, Ernest Santi, and Johnny Duchane.

Such sites as the city hall, post office, and churches will be shown. Most of the business places in Highwood and vicinity have cooperated with the committee to make the motion picture a success. A number of action shots have been taken such as: a fire run by the Highwood Fire Department, the Highland Park-Highwood Drum and Bugle Corps on parade, children being dismissed from school, and activities of various organizations.

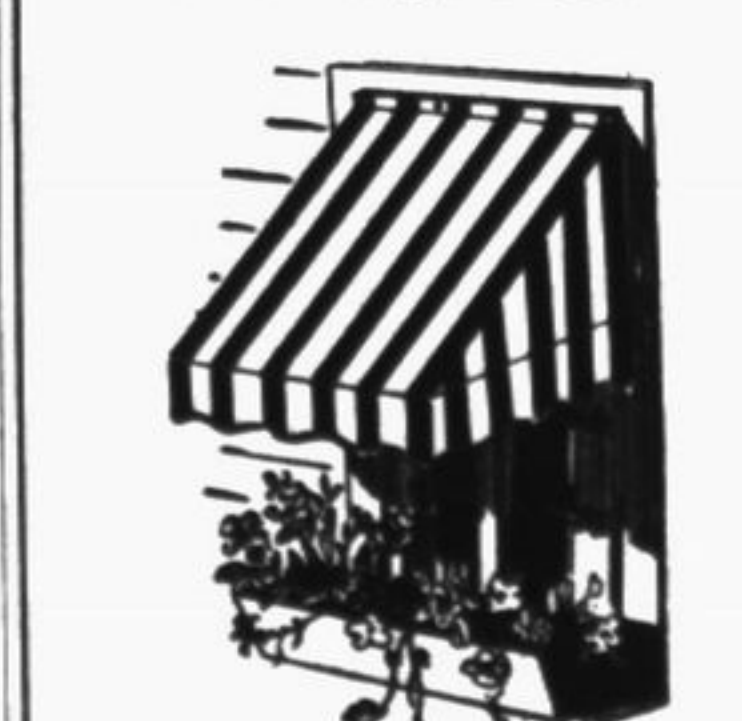

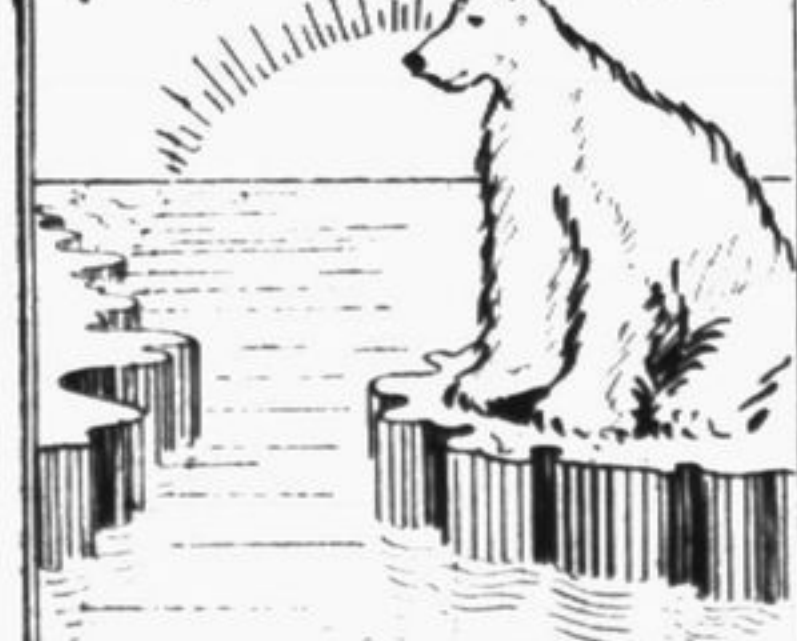
