### Urge Protest to Recent Rejection Of Ramspeck Bill

You as a conscientious voter should understand the significance of the Ramspeck Bill (H.R. 960) and of the House's very recent rejection of it, for there is still a fighting chance of getting it through if protest is quick and vigorous.

There are at present some 200,000 positions in the federal government not under civil service. They are plums which Congressmen have been able to pick to reward the faithful. The Ramspeck Bill would put approximately 150,000 of these under civil service. Originally both the House and Senate passed the bill, but in varying forms which necessitated a joint conference. It is the report of this conference that the House, in a loose bi-partisan coalition, has now rejected. Representative Ramspeck has obtained a vote authorizing consideration by a second joint conference, but left to its own devices the House is not likely to revive it. The League of Women Voters believes this is your golden opportunity to swing into action with letters of protest to your Congressman.

The House has instructed its conferees to the second conference to insist that the Nichol amendment be included. This proposal would make absolutely rigid the application of the quota system which provides that each state has a right to a certain number of governmental jobs based on its population. This system creates many administrative difficulties and is not in accord with the best merit principles since, for example, an applicant who passes a civil service examination with a relatively low mark but who happens to come from a state with an unfilled quota takes precedence over an applicant who passed the exam with a much higher mark but who comes from a state where the quota is already filled.
