#### November Building Reaches Its Highest Level Since 1928

Reaching the highest building level since 1928, building for the month of November in Highland Park reached a record breaking total of \$214,114. This includes 12 dwellings valued at \$144,762, three private garages, \$925, three sheds, \$450, four alterations, \$567,477, and an additional fee of \$1,500, making a total of \$214,114.

The lowest building level during the twelve year period was in November, 1932, with a total of \$8,-680.

The accumulated value for the period from January to November, 1939, was \$1,013,096, while this year's accumulated value to November 1 is \$1,089,378, an increase of 7 per cent.
