## Chicago Stadium Opens Sonja Henie Ice Revue Dec. 26

Thursday, December 26th, the opening night of the 1941 Sonja Henie Hollywood Ice Revue, will mark the inception of the busiest 18

winter days in the history of the Chicago Stadium. The Stadium, the largest indoor arena in the world, has never witnessed anything like the diversified activity which will include the Sonja Henie Revue, hockey games, the professional tennis tour and a prize fight.

On December 26th, Sonja Henie will invade the west side arena with her newest ice creation to run nightly until the first of January. On the night of January 1st, the Chicago Blackhawks will take over the arena and battle the Detroit Red Wings. Then the Sonja Henie show will re-appear on January 2nd, and continue through January 5th. January 8th will bring a change to the playing area with the coming of the professional tennis tour, promoted by Jack Harris and starring Alice Marble, Marry Hardwick, Bill Tilden and Don Budge. Then on January 10th the first major fight of the 1941 season will take place at the Stadium when Middleweight Champion Tony Zale meets Steve Mamakos in a nontitle bout. Sunday, January 12th will windup the maze of activity, unequaled since the Stadium first swung its doors open in 1929, when the Blackhawks do battle with the Detroit Red Wings.
