

Former Head of the International News Bureau Speaks Here

James R. Young, who served for ten years as head of the International News Service Bureau in Tokyo, addressed members of the Exmoor Country club Sunday evening on "America Watches the Far East." Mr. Young was removed from his position and served 61 days in jail for sending dispatches to the United States which did not meet the approval of the Japanese government. Since his return to this country he has been making a series of talks in the middle west, and is writing two books on the Far East and doing broadcasting with CBS.

In his talk Mr. Young, who is a nephew of K. M. Patterson of this city, said "Japan is afraid of the United States and Russia—Japan's navy is opposed to the army and does not want a war with any power. Their vulnerable position between the United States' fleet and Russia's air force is of greater concern to Tokyo than America's concern over a two ocean navy problem. He also stated that the Axis alliance is a march of three pallbearers whistling in the dark thru an international graveyard."
