

School Districts To Elect Members of Boards Saturday

Annual school elections will be held Saturday in Highland Park. Polls will open at 12 noon and will close at 7 p.m. the same day.

In the high school district 105, there is only one candidate for election: George T. Rogers, whose term expires, is seeking re-election. Polls are located in the High School Auditorium, at Oak Terrace School and the Town Hall, Deerfield.

In District 107, there will be no opposition in the election Saturday, April 12. The incumbent president, Francis M. Knight, is unopposed. Herman A. Zaeske is a candidate for re-election and Mrs. Irene M. Joselyn has also filed for membership. The terms of Mr. Zaeske and Mrs. Roderick MacPherson expire this year. District 107 includes Green Bay Road School and Elm Place School. Polling place will be at the Elm Place School.

In District No. 108 a President and two members of the Board of Education will be elected Saturday.

Petitions have been filed for John B. Jackson, present incumbent, for President of the Board of Education; for Jess Halsted, present incumbent, Mortimer Singer and Maurice A. Pollak for members of the Board of Education.

District 108 has been divided into two precincts. Precinct No. 1, polling place at the Lincoln School, S. Green Bay Road. Precinct No. 2, polling place at the Ravinia School, Roger Williams Avenue.
