HURT IN ACCIDENT ON SKOKIE ROAD

Miss Nancy Kaufman, 234 East Park avenue, who is a patient at the Highland Park hospital, suffering from injuries sustained in an automobile accident on Skokie road last Thursday, is getting along as well as can be expected.

Miss Kaufman, on her way to Chicago to take a music lesson, reached over to gather her scattered music in the front seat, and lost control of her car. The car struck the shoulder and veered across the parkway into the path of a north-bound auto, driven by Arthur N. Henriksen, Chicago. Henriksen was treated at the hospital for face and leg cuts, and a possible nose fracture.

Miss Kaufman is suffering from internal injuries and head and knee injuries.
