The material shall be basic shall contain not less than 17 per cent available water soluble alumina (AL₂O₃), and shall not contain more than 0.75 per cent iron (Fe₂O₃)

It shall contain not more than 0.5 per cent of material insoluble in distilled water.

It shall be ground for use in dry feed machines, and shall be of such size that not less than 85 per cent shall pass a woven sieve having ten meshes per linear inch, and 100 per cent shall pass a sieve having four meshes per linear inch.

AN ORDINANCE by the Board of Trustees of the Highland Park Mosquito Abatement District Adopting a Budget and Appropriating Money for Its Corporate Purposes for the Fiscal Year Ending May 31, 1942.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE HIGHLAND PARK MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. That the following be and the same hereby is adopted as the Budget for the Highland Park Mosquito Abatement District for the fiscal year ending May 31, 1942:

ESTIMATED REVENUES

- Balance of cash on hand on June 1, 1941 \$ 200.00
- Estimated revenue from County Collector of Lake County, representing taxes extended and levied for the year 1940 and prior years, less loss and cost of collection 7,000.00

Total \$7,200.00

3. Estimated expenditures as set forth in Section 2 hereof \$9,135.00

4. Estimated balance of cash on hand at close of fiscal year None

SECTION 2. That the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law and as may be needed, be and the same hereby are appropriated for the corporate purposes of the Highland Park Mosquito Abatement District as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year ending May 31, 1942:
