Christian Science Lecture

A lecture on Christian Science entitled Christian Science: The Science of God's Abundant Provision by Harold Molter, C.S.B. of Chicago, Illinois, Member of the Board of Lectureship of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Massachusetts, was given Saturday evening in the Elm Place school.

The lecturer spoke substantially as follows:

In the New Testament the words and works of Christ Jesus, the great Way-shower for all men, illumine the inspired pages of the Scriptures with a great spiritual light. Just as Jesus came in response to Biblical prophecy, to reveal and prove God's everpresent abundance of spiritual good, so Mrs. Eddy's discovery and mission were in response to Jesus' promise that the Comforter would come and reveal all things to mankind. In Science and Health Mrs. Eddy, through divine inspiration, has restored to mankind the primitive Christianity taught and practiced by Jesus.
