Frosh-Soph and Varsity Mermen Lose To New Trier

Facing perhaps the toughest foe they will encounter this season, the Highland Park frosh-soph and varsity swim teams fell before New Trier's swimmers in a meet held last Thursday in the Winnetkan's pool.

New Trier's varsity won by an impressive 64 to 11 score. The local varsity had previously defeated Niles and Maine in practice meets, and Waukegan in the first Suburban league meet of the year.

New Trier's frosh-soph team swept to victory in every event but one and registered a 48 to 18 triumph. Mort Moss captured the only first place finish which Highland Park was able to salvage. He took the diving honors. The 150-yard medley relay and the 200-yard free style relay were close, but New Trier had enough good team work to pull through to victories in both. This was the first defeat of the year for the frosh-soph, who had previously romped over Niles, Maine and Waukegan.

The only consoling factor of the meet for Highland Park was a 24 to 24 tie gained by a local freshman team with the freshmen from New Trier.

Highland Park captured four first place finishes and two second place finishes in racking up their twenty-four points. Arlen Rubenstein took the 50-yard breaststroke; Paul Day, the 100-yard crawl; and Stanwood, the 50-yard backstroke. The fourth first place finish was registered by the 150-yard medley relay team composed of Stanwood, Rubenstein, and Keim.

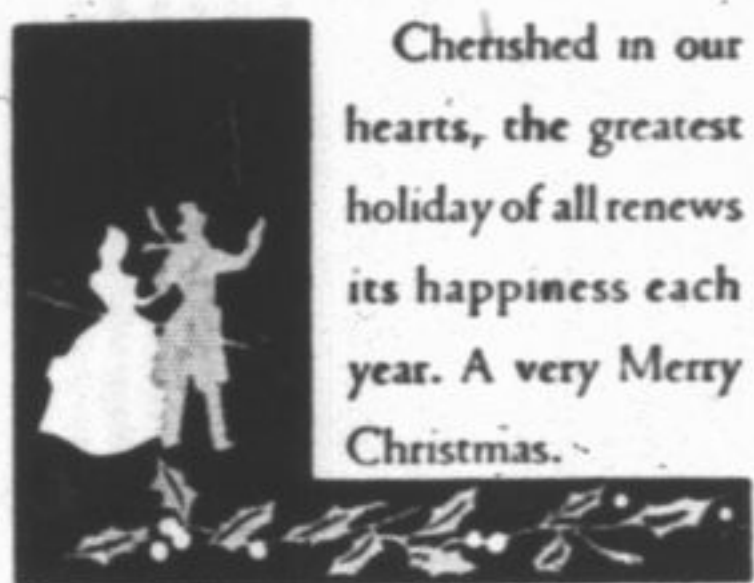
