AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A TRAFFIC COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PASSED MARCH 10, 1941, APPROVED MARCH 11, 1941" (AND AMENDING SCHEDULE III ATTACHED THERETO)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. That Schedule III attached to and made a part of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Creating a Traffic Commission and Establishing Traffic Regulations for the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, Passed March 10, 1941, Approved March 11, 1941", being that portion of Schedule III under the sub-heading "Parking Limited to 1 1/2 hours between 8 o'clock A. M. and 6 o'clock P. M. on any day (exception Sundays and legal holidays)", be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Upon the east side of that portion of St. Johns Avenue beginning with the north line of its intersection with Roger Williams Avenue in the City of Highland Park and extending north upon said east side for a distance of 250 feet.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recodation and publication as required by law.

That Schedule I attached to and made a part of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Creating a Traffic Commission and Establishing Traffic Regulations for the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, Passed March 10, 1941, Approved March 11, 1941", be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto under that portion of such schedule prohibiting parking at any time, as follows:

On the north side of Glenview Avenue from the easterly line of Exmoor Avenue, easterly for a distance of 200 feet, and

On the south side of Glenview Avenue from the easterly line of Exmoor Avenue to the westerly line of Midlothian Avenue.
