IN 1892 THE FIRST CHURCH WAS BUILT IN IRON BRIDGE. REV. FRY WAS THE MINISTER AT THAT TIME. A FIRE WAS PUT ON TO DRY THE PLASTER, AND DURING THAT SAME NIGHT THE STOVE OVERHEATED AND COMPLETELY DESTROYED THIS LITTLE CHURCH.

REV. KITCHEN WAS SO ANXIOUS TO SEE A PLACE OF WORSHIP FOR HIS PEOPLE THAT HE SAID IF THEY WOULD SUPPLY THE MATERIAL, HE WOULD RAISE ENOUGH MONEY FOR THE CASH OUTLAY. HE VISITED THE DIFFERENT LUMBER CAMPS IN OUR AREA AND ENTERTAINED THE MEN WITH HIS HAND ORGAN, THEN TOOK UP A COLLECTION TO ASSIST IN FINANCING THE CHURCH. THE PEOPLE GAVE TIME AND MATERIAL AND IN THIS WAY THE CHURCH WAS COMPLETELY OUT OUT OF DEBT IN THE YEAR IT WAS BUILT
