- 1934 THE WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION WAS ORGANIZED BY REV. O. W. HOLMES.
  MR. HOLMES PLANTED THE EXISTING PINE AND SPRUCE TREES IN
  FRONT OF THE FORMER MANSE.
- 1936 REV. STYMIEST ORGANIZED THE TRAIL RANGERS AND THE C.G.I.T. (CANADIAN GIRLS IN TRAINING) GROUPS.
- 1940'S- THE YOUNG PEOPLES GROUP PAID FOR THE ELECTRICAL WIRING FOR THE CHURCH.
- 1941 WALTER THOMPSON, TEACHER OF THE ONE-ROOM SCHOOL WITH TEN GRADES AND 60 PUPILS, ALSO TOOK TIME TO BE TRAIL RANGER AND AND YOUNG PEOPLE'S LEADER.
- 1949 DEAN LAKE UNITED CHURCH CONGREGATION JOINED WITH IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH.
  - THE LARGE WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION WAS DIVIDED INTO JUNIOR AND SENIOR GROUPS.
- 1951 REV. C. B. GRAHAM WORKED DUTSIDE OF THE CHURCH AS WELL AS MINISTERING IN THE CHURCH. FALLING INTO BRIGHT LAKE DURING THE MARCH CUTTING OF ICE BLOCKS FOR REFRIGERATION, HE WAS RESCUED BY MR. JOHN TAIT. MR. TAIT LATER SAID, "I COULD TELL BY THE LOOK ON HIS FACE THAT HE WANTED OUT!"
- 1953 THE EXPLORER GROUP, ORGANIZED BY MRS. LOGAN EAGLE IN 1951, NEEDED FUNDS FOR THEIR ACTIVITIES, SO THEIR LEADERS, MRS. ROY NICHOLSON AND MRS. HARVEY ALLEN, APPROACHED MRS. WILLIAM BOVILLE (ANNE). SHE OFFERED THE HISTORICAL ACCOUNT OF THE IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH THAT SHE HAD WRITTEN. PRINTED FREE BY MARY ALLEN'S FORMER HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, FRANK PURDY OF BLIND RIVER. THE EXPLORERS SOLD ALL THEIR COPIES.
- 1954 REV. WALLY DAMM LETTERED IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME ON THE COMMUNION TABLE BUILT BY MR. BOB NICHOLSON. HE ALSO ARTISTICALLY PAINTED THE BANNER AT THE FRONT OF THE SANCTUARY BY GRACE ARE YE SAVED THROUGH FAITH.
- 1956 AN ANNEX WAS BUILT ON THE SOUTHERN END OF THE CHURCH TO HOUSE THE SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES. IT ALSO CONTAINED A KITCHEN AREA AND A BATHROOM.
- 1957 PATTON UNITED CHURCH CONGREGATION JOINED WITH THE IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH.
- 1958 REV. J. HILL INSTIGATED THE ORGANIZATION OF SCOUTS AND CUBS IN IRON BRIDGE.
  - DURING REV. JAMES LEMON'S MINISTRY, THE TIME FOR CHURCH WAS CHANGED FROM EVENING TO MORNING.
- 1960 A NEW ELECTRIC ORGAN WAS PURCHASED TO REPLACE THE OLD PUMP ORGAN. ORGANISTS WERE MRS. OLIVE LARONE AND MRS. PAUL PICK.
