

- 1962 - 70TH ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIVE PLATES WERE PRODUCED AND SOLD.
- 1963 - REV. BOB RUMBALL, WELL KNOWN CHAMPION OF THE DEAF, VISITED THE CHILDREN OF REV. DOUG & VANGE WARREN'S "GOOD NEWS BIBLE CLUB". THOSE WHO WERE CHILDREN IN 1963 WILL REMEMBER REV. RUMBALL FOR MAGICIAN'S TRICKS OF PICKING QUARTERS FROM THE EARS OF UNSUSPECTING BOYS AND GIRLS.
- 1966 - THE IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH ANNEX WAS RENTED TO THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO BE USED AS A CLASSROOM WITH MRS. MARY STOBIE AS TEACHER.
- 1967 - IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH 75TH ANNIVERSARY.
- 1968 - NEW WINDOWS WERE INSTALLED IN THE SANCTUARY, PURCHASED BY MEMBERS OF THE CONGREGATION IN MEMORY OF THEIR LOVED ONES.
 - REV. JOHN BROWN WAS THE LEADER OF AN ACTIVE GROUP OF YOUNG PEOPLE DURING HIS YEARS OF SERVICE. AT ONE TIME THE GROUP CONSISTED OF AT LEAST 8 BOYS AND ONE GIRL - EMILY MOSHER!
- 1971 - REV. PAUL LEE ORGANIZED THE COUPLE'S CLUB WITH MEMBERSHIP OPEN TO ALL COUPLES OF THE AREA. THIS GROUP SPEARHEADED THE PREPARATIONS FOR THE EASTER SUNRISE BREAKFASTS. HE HELPED TO CLARIFY THE ADMINISTRATIVE WORKINGS OF THE CHURCH BY INTRODUCING US TO THE UNITED CHURCH MANUAL. THE CHARGE PUBLISHED ITS FIRST ANNUAL REPORTS. REV. LEE ALSO PREPARED AND PRINTED THE FIRST WEEKLY CHURCH BULLETINS AS A REGULAR FEATURE.
- 1973 - TED LINLEY WAS ELECTED CHAIRPERSON OF THE PASTORAL CHARGE OFFICIAL BOARD, THE FIRST TIME A LAY PERSON HAS SERVED THIS POSITION.
- 1975 - AS A PROJECT FOR THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY YEAR OF THE UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA, THE HISTORY OF THE IRON BRIDGE PASTORAL CHARGE WAS BROUGHT UP TO DATE, COMPLETE WITH PICTURES. A BOOKLET WAS PRINTED UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF REV. MAX JOHNSON, MRS. EDITH CAMERON, MRS. EARL BROCK AND MRS. HARVEY ALLEN.
 - RETIRED MINISTER, REV. GEORGE GORMAN FILLED IN DURING A TIME WHEN THERE WAS A SHORTAGE OF MINISTERS.
 - GWEN MOSHER AND TED LINLEY LED THE YOUNG PEOPLE'S GROUP.
- 1978 - THE JUNIOR CHOIR WAS REVIVED UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF NANCY MUNDELL AND PIANIST JANICE CAMERON.
 - DAYTON UNITED CHURCH CONGREGATION JOINED WITH THE IRON BRIDGE UNITED CHURCH.
