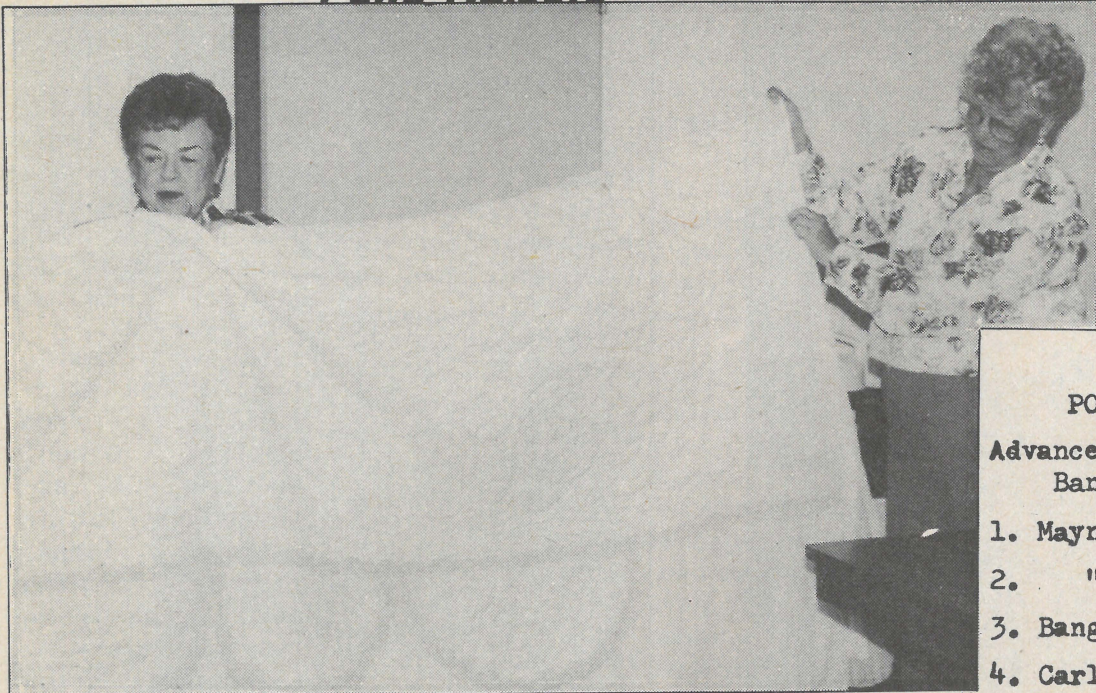


### Hospital Auxiliary Holds Fund-Raisers
