For that reason, tickets are being offered, beginning August 5, to former Concert Series subscribers.

Any tickets left over will be available to the public about September 1, until supplies run out.

There is one price this year: \$40 per person for a concert series ticket. Tickets to both Concert Series would sell for \$70 per person.
