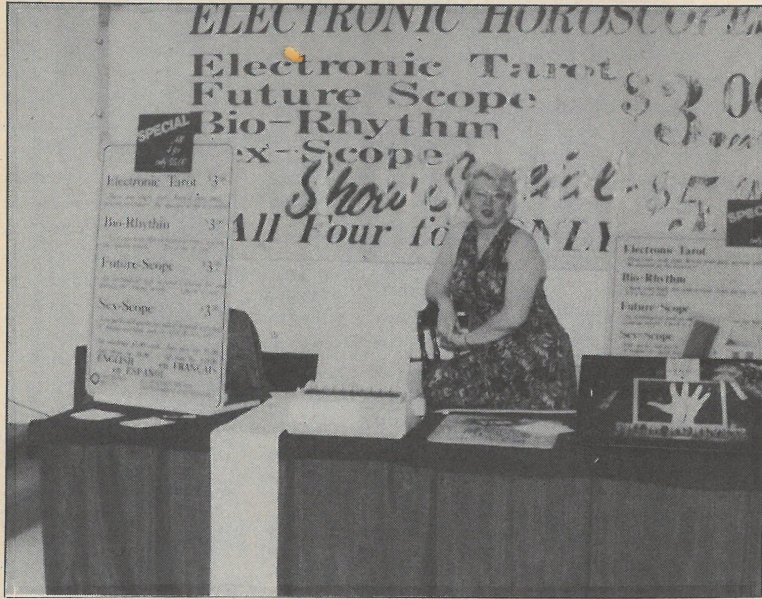


Psychic Fair in Bancroft
