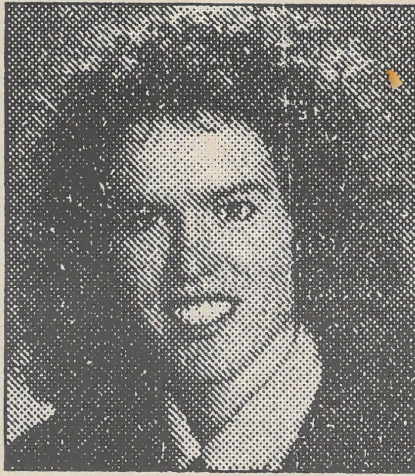

Currently a member of a team at First United in Owen Sound, she has also received training from Annesley United in Markdale, and Wilberforce and Gooderham United Churches.

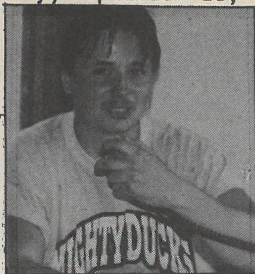
"I am sure I will discover new ways to love, serve and celebrate in ministry," she adds.

library, guest speakers, workshops on women's rights) is funded by the Ontario Women's Directorate to provide service, public education and political action on women's issues.

Tamarack is sponsored by Maggie's but is separate Trillium Foundation funds social progress projects for the economically disadvantaged in Ontario through the Ontario Lottery Corporation and Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Recreation. It

is not funded through tax payers' dollars. The rural outreach worker will be available to meet with women in their own homes starting in early October.
