BUTTER TART SQUARES (to die for) 1 cup of margarine (Don't use butter – it burns)

2 cups of flour

1/4 cup of icing sugar

Mix and press onto the bottom and slightly up the sides of an ungreased

2 cups brown sugar 1/2 cup melted margarine (not butter)

4 beaten eggs

2 tbsp vinegar
2 tsp vanilla

Mix and pour over base.

Optional to add

1 cup raisins (soften in hot water first - drain & dry)
cup pecans (yummie)

cup feather strip coconut. Sprinkle any or all 3 over top of

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes, if you like them gooey
- or 40 minutes to slice neatly.

Be sure to wait several minutes because they will burn a child's (or adult's) mouth. I know it will hard to keep them waiting; but it's for their own good.


