

and medical comforts was \$200, and for beer, wine and spirits, \$1,600, while for the Toronto Asylum the estimate for the same purpose was \$420 and \$3,000 respectively, which was, taking the respective number of inmates into account, 51 per cent. in excess of London.

Mr. WOOD said the estimates were prepared by the superintendents themselves. One superintendent, he supposed, classed more articles under the head of medical comforts than the other. They differed in opinion; Dr. Workman approved of using more stimulants than did Dr. Landor.

Mr. BLAKE said the estimate for butchers' meat for the Toronto Asylum was also about 52 per cent. in excess of the same estimate for the London Asylum. He suggested that in future the nomenclature of the details of the estimates for the two asylums be made the same, so that a comparison could be made between them, which was impossible as the wording now stood.
