CENTRAL PRISON.

On motion of Attorney-General Mowat the House went into Committee on the resolution respecting the contract between the Canada Car Co. and the Government for the labour of the prisoners in the Central Prison, Mr. Hodgins in the Chair.

Mr. CAMERON moved that the second clause of the contract be amended by striking out the word "prisoners" and inserting the words "as many prisoners as may be from time to time in the said prison."

Attorney-General MOWAT observed that there could be no risk to the Government in guaranteeing 215 prisoners, as it was probable that double that number would be in the prison.

The amendment was declared lost, Mr. Cameron intimating that he would divide the House upon it when the Speaker was in the chair. Mr. Cameron also announced that he would move an amendment with respect to damages.

The Committee then rose and reported the resolution.

PUBLIC HEALTE.

On motion of Attorney General MOWAT, the House went into Committee on the Bill especting the Public Health, Mr. Hodgins in the chair. The Bill was reported without amendment and fixed for a third reading.

Attorney-General MOWAT moved that the House adjourn.

Mr CAMERON asked when they would have the Municipal Loan Fund scheme.

Attorney-General MOWAT said he could not say anything more definite than he had already stated. He would bring the scheme down as soon as he possibly could

The House then adjourned at 12:15.
