The experience I have had in this chair during the past two years has given me a fuller sense of the responsibilities and of the difficulties of this position, and a keener sense of how much and how often I shall still have to rely upon that indulgence. Gentlemen, I thank you for the very high honour you have paid me—a compliment which I shall endeavour to the utmost of my power to merit.
