Mr CAMERON asked when they might expect a return of the licenses lesued last year and the year before. He understood that all the information from which the return could be compiled was on file in the Treasurer's Department, or from the Department of the Provincial Secretary.

Mr. WOOD said all the droulars had been sent out at the earliest moment, as he had stated before.

Mr. CROOKS said that the names of the license holders were not kept on file in any of the Departments. The blank licenses were signed by the Treasurer, and for warded to the Commissioners, who, as officers of the Government, kept the names, etc., on file.
