Mr. Crooks—On Friday next—That a Select Committee be appointed to consider and report on the subject of sanitary measures for maintaining and promoting the public health, with power to send for persons and papers, and that such Committee do consist of the Hon. Mr. Crooks, Messrs. Barr, Baxter, Boulter, Clarke (Norfolk), Harkin, McMahon, Mostyn, O'Sullivan, Widdifield, and Wilson.

Mr. Mowat—On Friday next—Bill to provide for offenders against Provincial and municipal laws being put to hard labour outside of gaol limits.

Also—Bill respecting the law of landlord and tenant.

Also—Bill to provide for the winding up of joint stock companies in certain cases.

Also—Bill to regulate the Civil Service of the Province.

Also—Bill to confirm the Revised Statutes of Ontario.

Also—Bill respecting accommodation for the Maritime Court of Ontario.

Also—Bill respecting the Magistracy.

Mr. Wood—On Friday next—Bill for the registration of Municipal Loan Fund debentures.

Mr. Fraser—On Friday next—Bill to give finality to voters' lists, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

Mr. Crooks—On Friday next—Bill to make the Act respecting religious institutions applicable, under certain conditions, to the property of the Church of England in Canada.

Mr. Hardy—On Friday next—Bill respecting Courts of Oyer and Terminer, and general Gaol Delivery.

Mr. Mowat—On Friday next—Resolution, that the sessional orders respecting the elections of members on double returns be standing orders of the House.

Mr. Clarke (Norfolk)—On Monday next—Select Committee to amend the 1st and 2nd rules of the House, by providing that the time for the ordinary meetings of the House shall be at an earlier hour than 3 o'clock in the afternoon.

Mr. Bethune—On Monday next—"Bill to provide for cumulative voting for municipal purposes."

Also—On Monday next—"Bill to amend the law respecting trial by jury."

Hon. Atty.-Gen. Mowat—On Monday next—Select Committee, to assist Mr. Speaker in the care of the Library.

Also—On Monday next—Committee to select the several Standing Committees ordered by the House.

Mr. Deacon—On Tuesday next—Enquiry of Ministry, whether it is the intention of the Government to introduce any measure this session for the preservation of timber on Crown lands from destruction by fire.
