words added to the original resolution :--That this House desires to express its gratification that the advantages of the Agricultural College have so enlisted the attention and support of the farming community of the country, that the farmers' sons who apply for admission are greatly in excess of the accommodation provided by

the College."

After some discussion,

Mr. MOWAT would be very glad to reduce the expenditure on that or any other item, but it was not possible the Government could do so. He then proceeded to argue that considering the ability of Mr. Johnson, the Principal, his salary was far from being too large. His qualities were of a very high order; his learning was extensive; and his administrative abilities formed

strong recommendations.

Remarks were then made by Messrs. Hargraft, Graham, Cameron, and Lauder, after which the amendments were put and the amendment to the amendment declared carried on the following division :-
