PUBLIC BILLS.

The following Bills were read the second time :—

Mr. Young—To amend the Consolidated Municipal Act.

Mr. French—To amend the Fire Insurance Policy Act. The Bill provides for the appointment of an arbitrator in case one party neglects or refuses to do so.

THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT.
