

Mr. Haycock said that the County of Frontenac had received more benefit from expenditures by the agent of the Government than by the County Council.

After Mr. Hardy had spoken, the motion was defeated by a vote of 58 to 31. Messrs. McDonald, Gamey, McLaren, Dynes, Kidd, Shore and Haggerty voting against, and Mr. Haycock and the other Patrons and Mr. Beatty (Parry Sound) with the Government.

Mr. Howland moved to strike out the item of \$100 for forestry. The motion was defeated by a vote of 31 to 58. This ended the divisions.

A number of bills were advanced a stage. The House adjourned at 12.21 p. m.
