## Immigration and Loan Corporations Bills Reported.

Legislative Chamber, March 23.

This was a poor day for the galleries but a good one for public business in the Legislature. Much work and little talking resulted in putting through the committee stage two important Government measures promoted by the Commissioner of Crown Lands—the bill to regulate the immigration into Ontario of certain classes of children, and the bill respecting loan companies. These bills were carefully considered, improved wherever possible, and reported. In addition to this satisfactory progress was made with the agricultural estimates. Two bills were introduced, one by Mr. Currie, the Member for West Simcoe, and the other by Hon. Mr. Gibson. Mr. Currie introduced legislation to better secure the independence of the Legislative Assembly. This is the bill introduced by Mr. Currie last session. It provides that no person shall be appointed to any office under the Government of Ontario to which any salary, emolument or profit is attached while he is a member of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario or within one year
