The Railway Committee of the House met yesterday and passed the Strathroy & Western Counties and the Smith Falls & Radial Railway bills. It was intimated by Mr. Dryden, the Chairman, that the bill of the Toronto-Scarboro' Railway Light and Power Company will be considered on Thursday.

A deputation of icemen will wait on the Government on Friday, to present their views in regard to that clause of the Lord's Day bill making legal the delivery of ice on Sunday. Another deputation will see the Government in regard to the bill on the 11th.

The Government propose to bring in a bill to make the salaries of civil servants subject to garnishee.
