## DEBATE STARTED.

Mover and Seconder of the Address Speke Yesterday.

## THEN DISCUSSION CEASED.

Mr. Whitney Wanted Time to Consider the West Elgin Commission and Was Given it.

The address in reply to the speech from the throne was moved and seconded in the Legislature yesterday, after which the debate was adjourned until Monday. Next week it will be resumed and continued from day to day until finished. It is uncertain how long the debate will last. Probably it will occupy the whole of Monday or Tuesday, and may extend into Wednesday. The adjournment of the debate took place at the request of Mr. Whitney, who said he had only received a copy of
