FERGUSON MURDER

Attorney-General Denounced For
Not Offering Reward.

DR. PYNE'S CRITICISMS.

Mr. Lumsden of Ottawa Makes Prac-
tical Suggestions Relative to the
Settlement of New Ontario.

Yesterday's session of the Legislature was quiet and almost uninteresting, except for the eloquent speech of Mr. Lumsden, the member for Ottawa. Mr. Lumsden made a fine reference to the conduct of the Canadians in South Africa, and the recent startling progress towards closer union of the empire. Dr. Pyne, member for East Toronto, spoke exhaustively, dealing with almost every question of Provincial politics, and a few outside matters. There was scarcely a quorum of members, and the galleries had few occupants. Dr. Pyne did not conclude his speech, and will continue on Monday.
