# An Unexpected Ending to the Budget Debate Last Night.

### MAJORITY OF 11.

The Prohibition Bill to be Introduced To-day.

#### HON. MR. DAVIS' SPEECH.

A Telling Criticism of the Opposition's Amendment-Mr. Crawford on His Connection With the Dakota Ranch.

A most unusual proceeding characterized the finish of the budget debate in the Legislature last night, when the discussion came to an end without the customary closing speeches from either Mr. Whitney or Premier Ross. Old officials state that this is the first instance of the kind in the history of the Provincial Legislature. At 9.30 Mr. Crawford concluded his address, and neither Mr. Whitney, who was expected to close the discussion on his side, nor any other member rose to continue the debate.
