Committee Approves Bill Now Before Legislature.

The Private Bills Committee yesterday approved the bill of Mr. A. B. Thompson of Centre Simcoe for the incorporation of the village of Port McNicol.

Mr. Peter White, K.C., on behalf of the town of North Bay, stated reasons for giving that town sanitary control of the watershed of Trout Lake. The chief reason was because the water supply was threatened.

Mr. G. F. Kilmer, K.C., opposed the bill as being too drastic by reason of the fact that North Bay wants control of the lake and river and lands surrounding it without payment.
