

DESERTED WIVES MAY RECEIVE AID

Old-age Pensions and Un- employment Insurance To be Discussed

As suggested in the addresses of several Labor members, the Ontario Government may take the initiative in inaugurating a conference of Provincial authorities on such Labor matters as old-age pensions and unemployment insurance. Information to this effect was given yesterday by Hon. Walter Rollo, Minister of Labor, to a deputation from the Trades and Labor Council.

Urged by the deputation to include within the scope of the Mothers' Allowance Act deserted wives and unmarried mothers, the Minister intimated that the former might be brought under the terms, but held out little hope in the case of mothers of illegitimate children.

The members of the deputation were Messrs. Stevenson, Simpson, Palmer, Rolph and Morgan.
