

"Try It on Toronto"

Seems Plan of Drury

Although G. G. Halcrow, Labor member for East Hamilton, pressed in the Legislature yesterday afternoon for consideration of his motion calling for an electoral system in Ontario "more in the line of representation by population," Premier Drury declared that the Government was not prepared to proceed with it.

A debate on the motion would, of course, entail definite pronouncement by the Drury Government of what its intentions are in connection with redistribution, which is due in Ontario this year. It is pretty well understood that the Government has decided not to redistribute before the election, but to have Toronto and York county vote on the proportional representation system.
