## OFFICIAL BIOGRAPHY PLANNED OF OUTSTANDING ONTARIO MEN

### Sir Adam Beck to Be Given Prominent Place in Educational Volume Which Will Be Prepared by Provincial Government

Premier Ferguson and his Ministry have under contemplation at the present time the compilation and publication of a volume for educational purposes that will deal with the careers of all outstanding men of the Province, and which, according to the Premier, will devote considerable space to the life and achievements of the late Sir Adam Beck. In conversation with *The Globe* yesterday, the Premier declared he knew of no better way to teach history than by biographies, and intimated

that the volume, when completed, would be a credit to all concerned.

The first information on this volume was supplied the Legislature yesterday by M. M. MacBride, Conservative member for Brant South, who, in reiterating his contention that a history of Sir Adam Beck should be written, was glad, he stated, to have the assurance from the Ministry that it was preparing the history described above. In speaking further of the matter, Mr. MacBride expressed pleasure at the support tendered his proposal by *The Globe*.

### *Will Ask That Amendment Be Ruled Out of Order*
