LIBERAL MEMBERS QUERY GOVERNMENT

Questions Asked Regarding F. H. Keefer, K.C., Settlement and J. McConnell

A further onslaught of questions has been launched by Liberal members of the Legislature against the Government.

W. A. Anderson (Peterboro' County), in a notice of motion, wants to know if F. H. Keefer, K.C., is still Legislative Secretary for Northern Ontario; if he is not, has a successor been named? Has Mr. Keefer been employed by the Government in any capacity since Dec. 1, 1926, and, if so, in what positions and with what remuneration?

T. Legault (Sturgeon Falls) wants information on what the Government is doing about opening the Townships of Ledger, Purdon and Booth, near Nipigon, for settlement.

A. A. Colquhoun (South Perth) wonders if John McConnell of Windsor, who resigned as Alderman during the recent investigation there, is the John McConnell who was Returning Officer for a Windsor riding in the recent Provincial election, and if he is the same John McConnell who is an inspector under the Luxury Tax Act of 1925.
