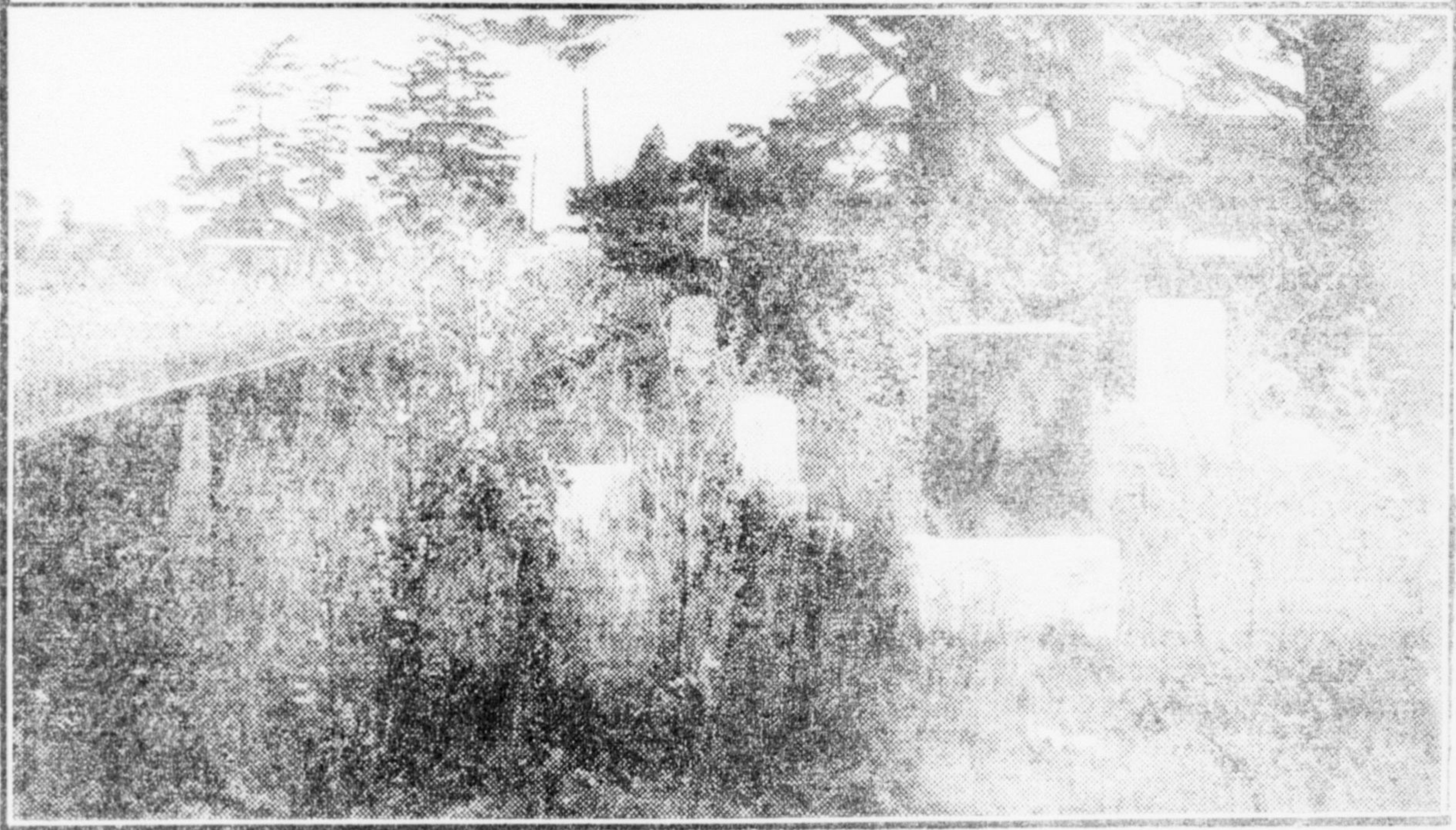
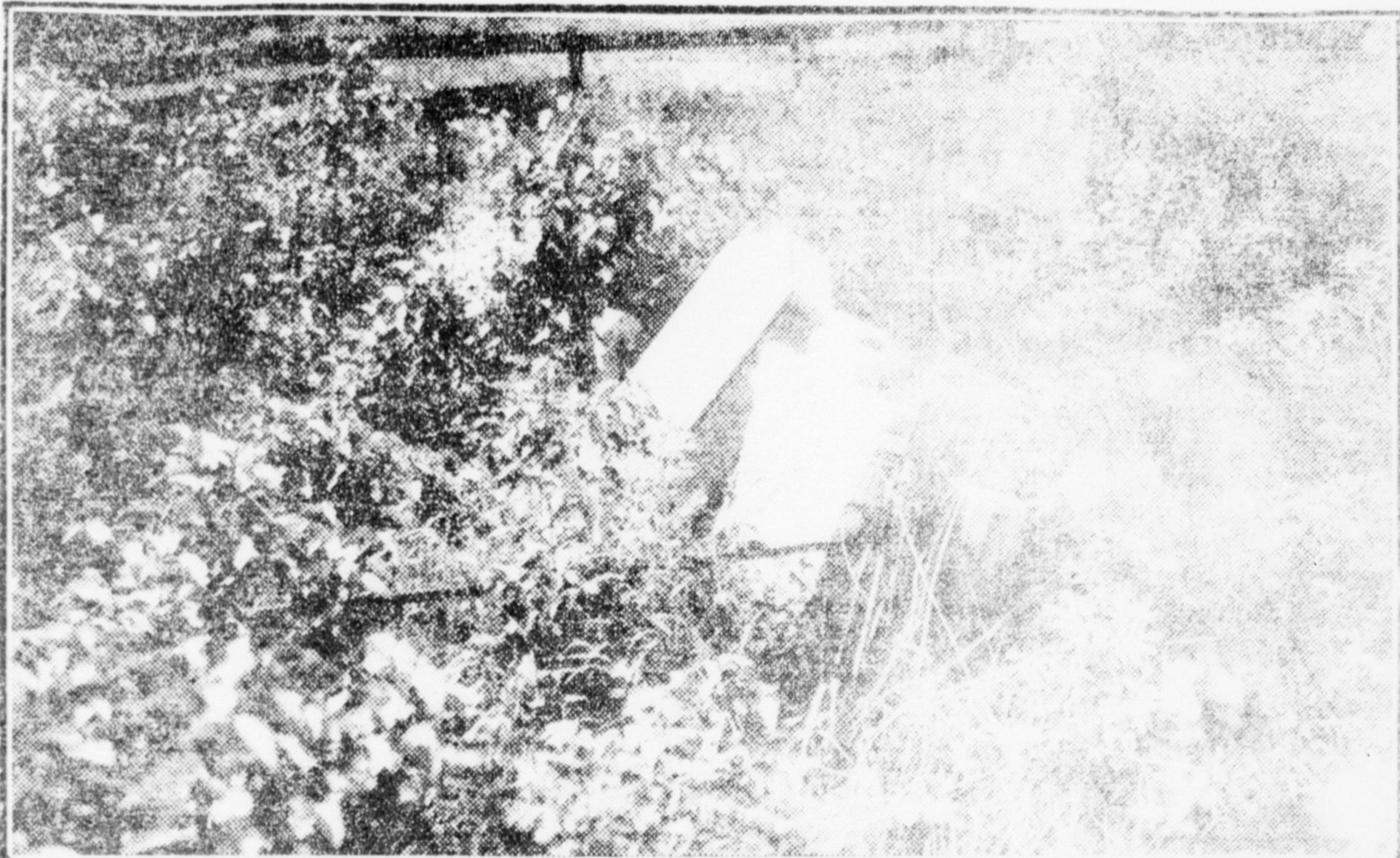

MAY BEAUTIFY NEGLECTED CEMETERIES



Announcement was made by Hon. Dr. Forbes Godfrey, Minister of Health and Labor, during Legislature consideration of the main estimates, that the extensive investigation made of Ontario's neglected cemeteries last summer by Dr. J. W. S. McCullough, Chief Medical Officer of Health, would be continued this year, in the hope that before long some plan of general improvement of conditions may be placed in operation. Many burial grounds are in a disgraceful state, Dr. Godfrey told the House—"in a condition that would make any one blush." It is the department's intention, he added, to proceed slowly, but effectively, in the process of "putting things right."
