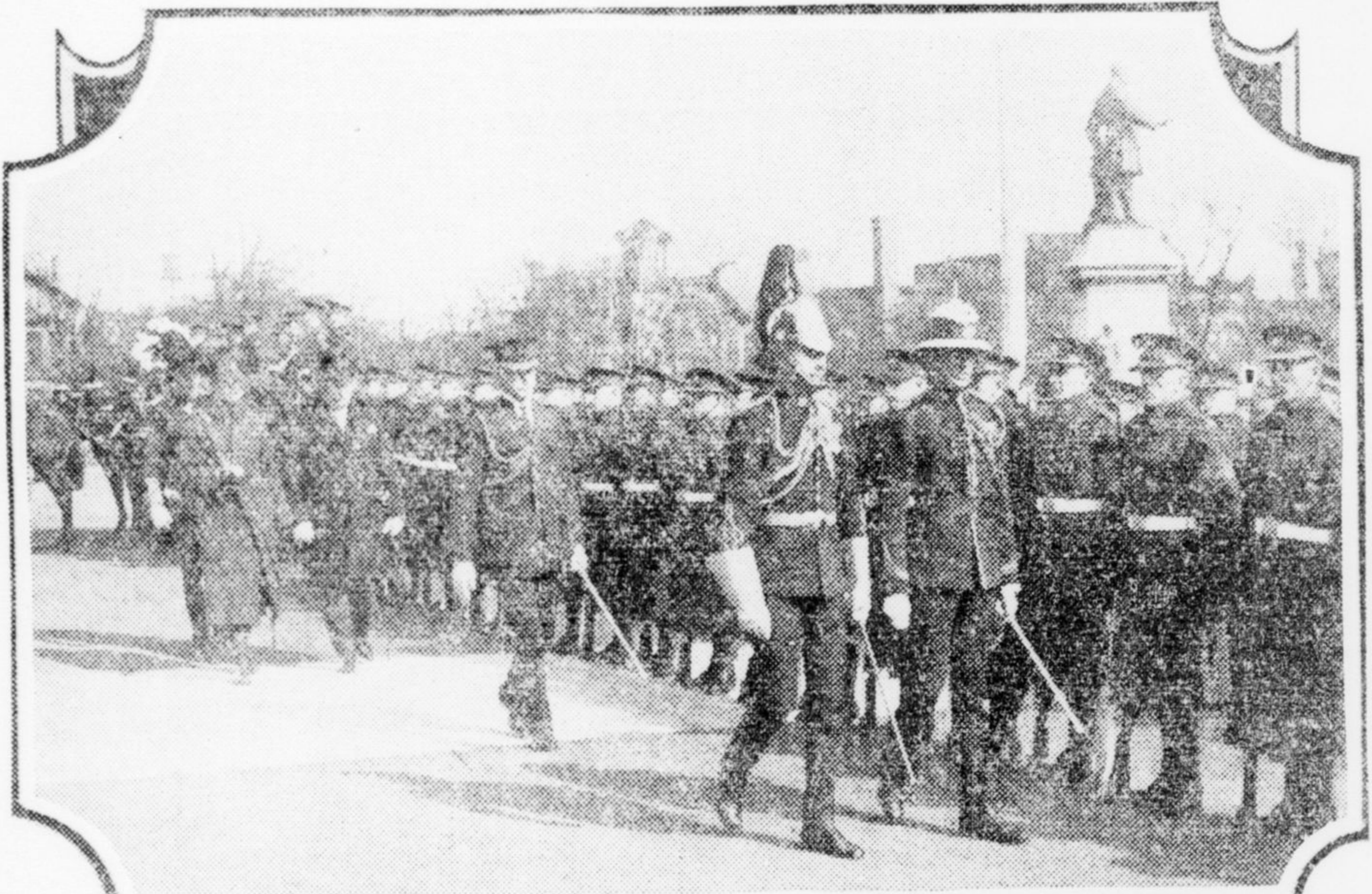

Ceremonial at Legislature Prorogation



The second session of the Eighteenth Legislative Assembly of Ontario came formally to an end yesterday amid the usual accompanying ceremony, Hon. William D. Ross, Lieutenant-Governor, giving assent to new acts, the Supply Bill, and reading the Speech from the Throne. Before entering the Buildings his Honor inspected the Guard of Honor.
