

thereon under their hands; and whether, presuming the allegations contained in the preamble to be moved to the satisfaction of the House, it is reasonable that such Bill do pass into law; and whether the provisions thereof are proper for carrying its purposes into effect; and what alterations or amendments, if any, are necessary in the same, and in the event of their approving the said Bill they are to sign the same; and the said Report, with the said Bill and Petition, are to be transmitted by the said Commissioners to the Clerk; and the Report shall be read by the Clerk at the Table, and shall be entered on the Journals of the House; and the Bill, together with the Report, shall stand referred to the Standing Committee on Private Bills, which is not to consider the said Bill before the delivery of the said Report, Bill and Petition to the Chairman of the said Committee.

74. In the event of the Commissioners of Estate Bills reporting that, in their opinion, it is not reasonable that the Bill submitted to them shall pass into law, such Bill shall not be further considered.
