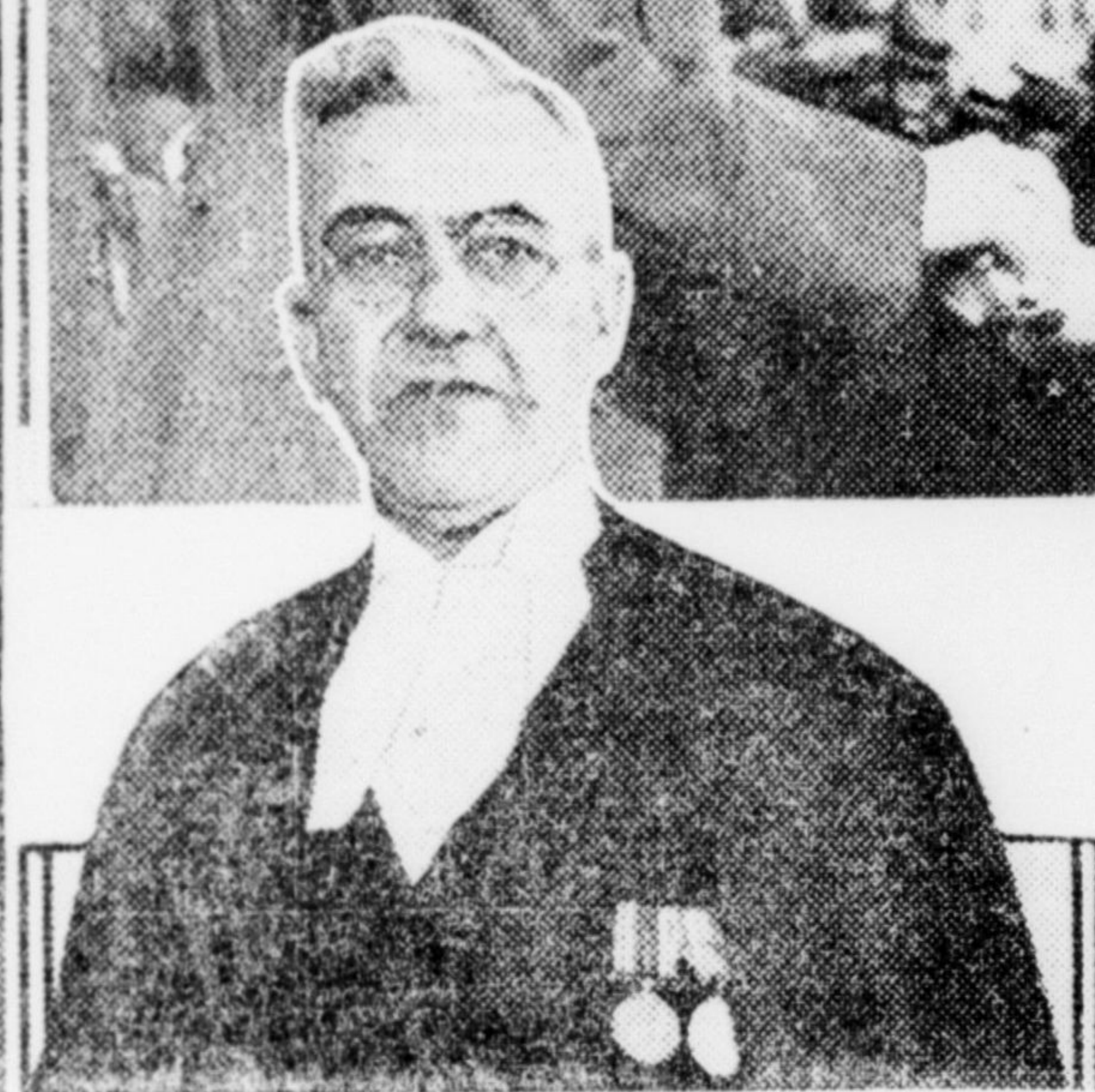


## *As Lawmakers of Ontario Start New Session*
